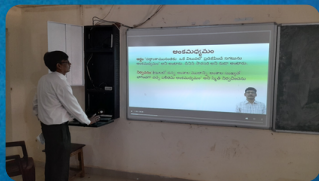

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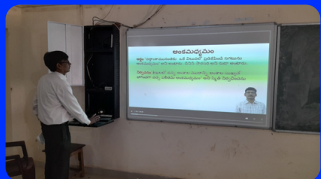
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Awareness Programme on Short-Term Internships for II Year Students

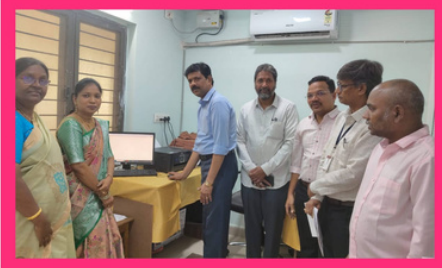

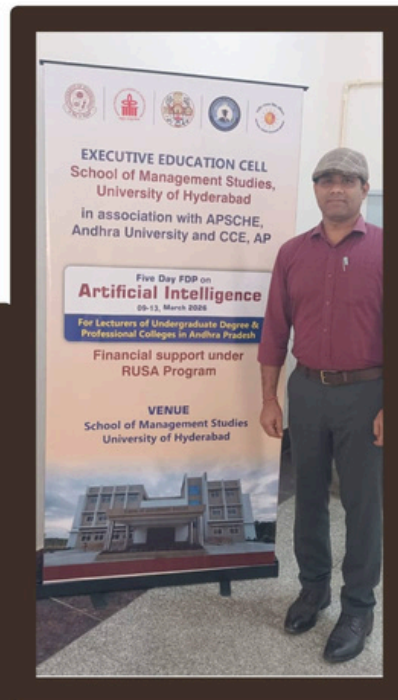
Nagendra jii Jayanthi Celebrate – Dept. of Hindi

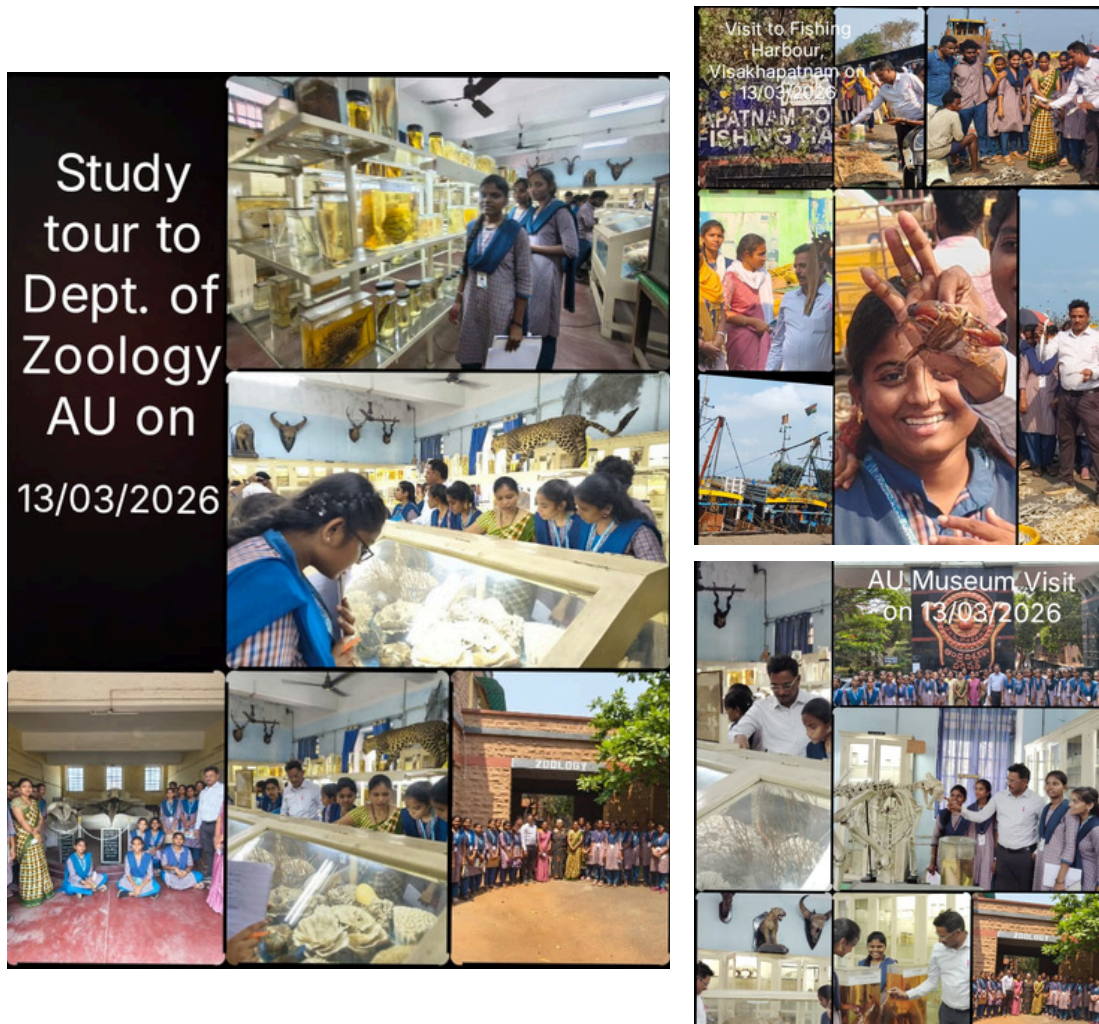
Students Achieve success at Job Mela

Celebrated the Birth Anniversary of Albert Einstein

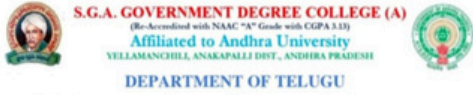

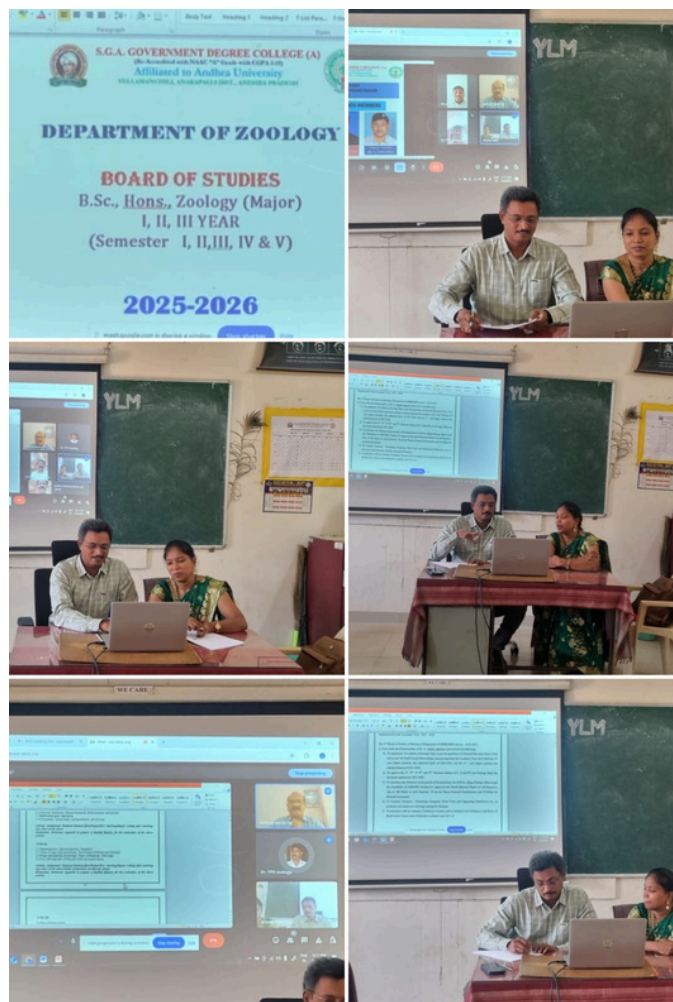
World Water Day Celebration by Department of Botany

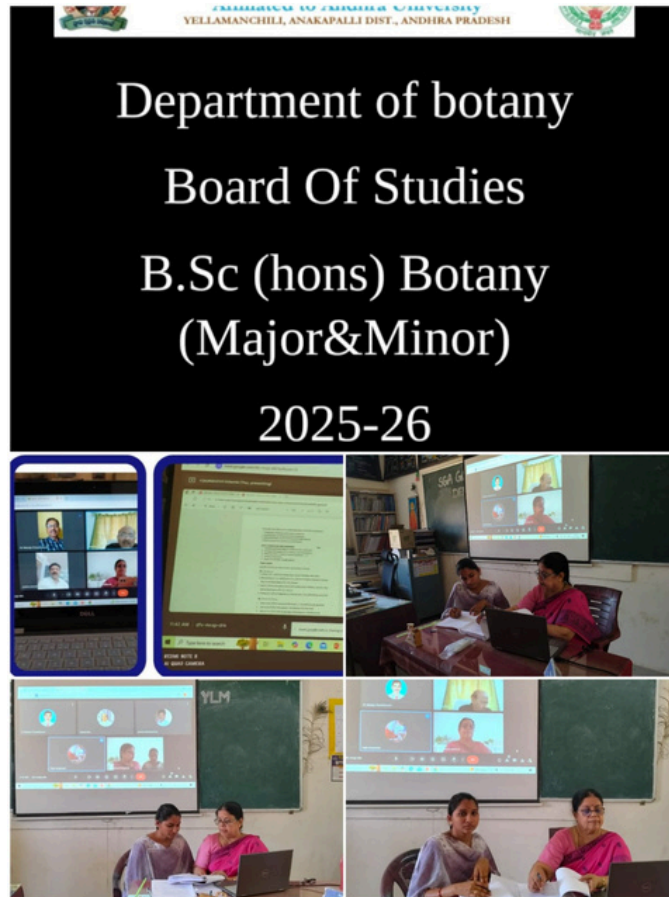
BOARD OF STUDIES – DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY

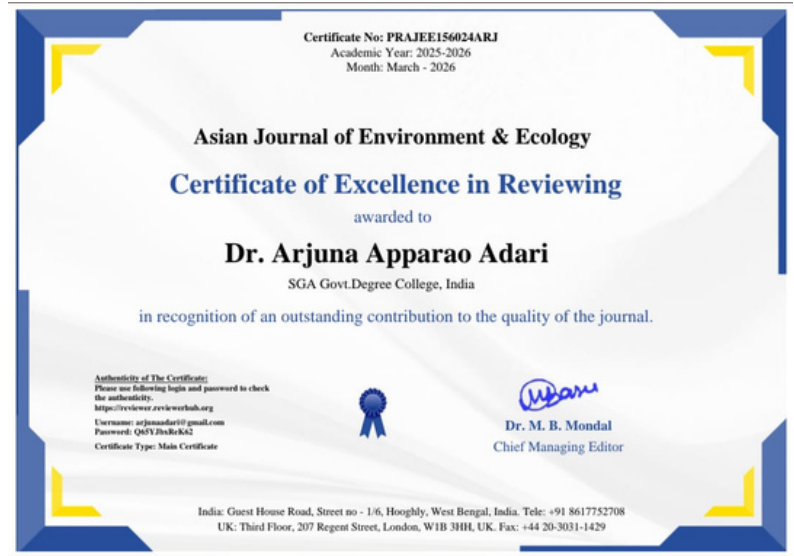
