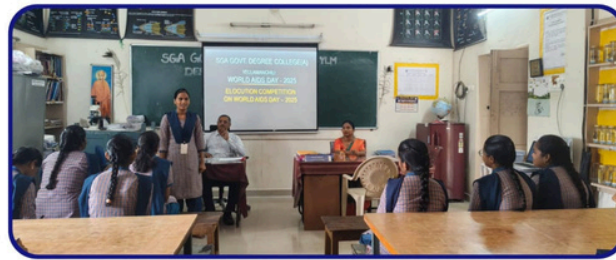
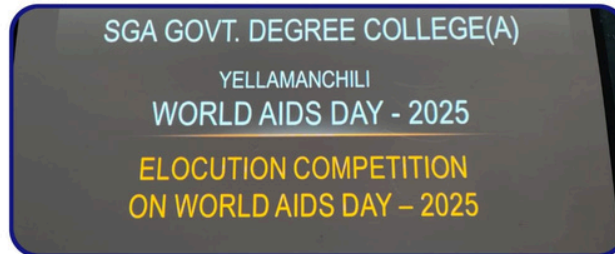
Rally and Awareness Program on World AIDS Day

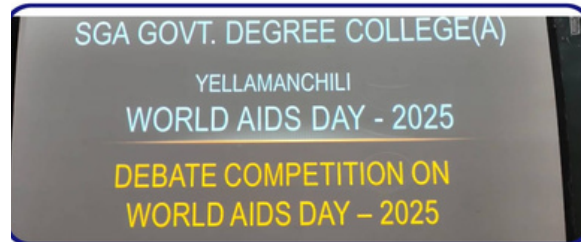
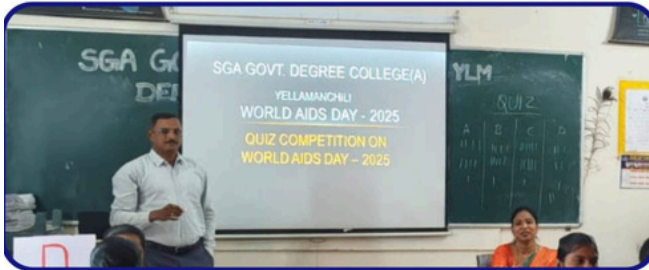
Elocution Competition on World AIDS Day

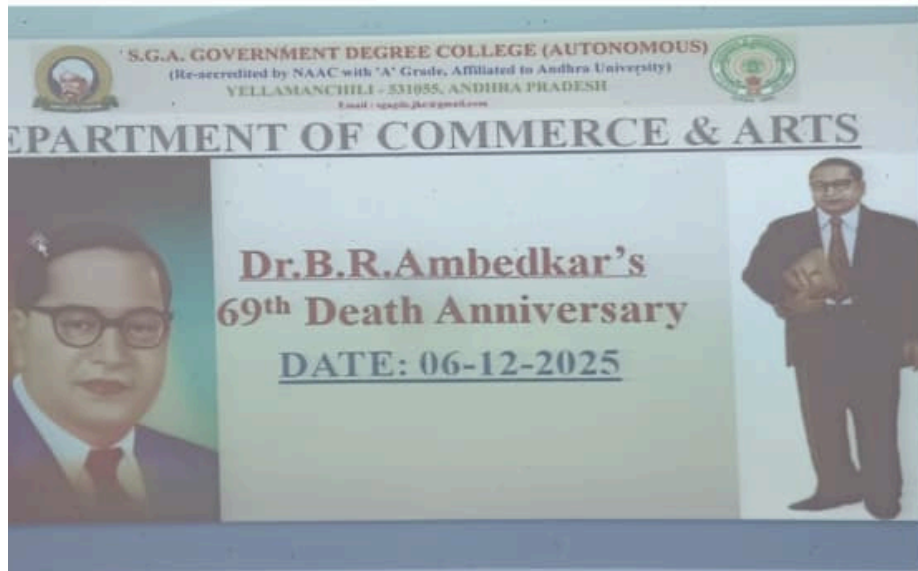
NSS Special Camp : Dental Problems and Precautions Awareness Programme

Educational Field Visit Organized by the Department of Botany

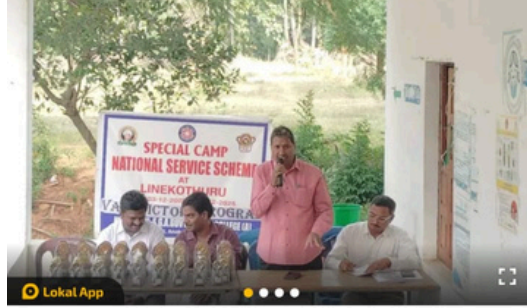
